

WELCA and children of the congregation will again be assembling school kits for Lutheran World Relief. We will place a box in the lobby area of the education building by mid-July to gratefully receive your contributions. It would be wonderful if we could fill at least 60 book bags. If you prefer, you may make a cash contribution and designate it for 'School Kits' on your offering envelope.

SCHOOL KITS provide supplies for children returning to school after the disruption of war; are given to children in refugee camps and may also be used in adult literacy classes. The following items are included in each school kit:

- · 70-80 sheet notebooks of wide or college ruled paper approximately 8" x 10-1/2", no loose-leaf paper.
- · Blunt scissors (safety scissors with imbedded steel blades work well)
- · 30-centimeter rulers, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other
- · Pencil sharpeners manual hand-held little ones no batteryoperated ones, please!
- · #2 pencils unsharpened with erasers
- · Black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink)
- · Boxes of 16 or 24 crayons
- . 2 1/2" erasers


